Volunteers are needed to help dismantle the Manger on Sunday, January 26th after the 11:00am Mass. Your help will be greatly appreciated.

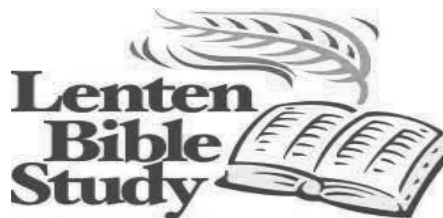


