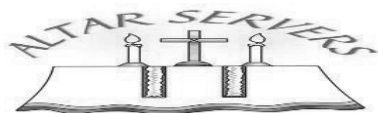

Dear Rev. Msgr. Patrick

Father Luis Carlos is 53 years old and was born in Mazatenango in Guatemala. He was ordained a priest on September 29, 1990 by Most Reverend Prospero Penados del Barrio, Archbishop of Guatemala. He has served in mission in the USA, Guatemala, and Italy. From 1991 through 1994 he worked in the Diocese of Wilmington Delaware ministering to migrant workers. From 1995 through 1996 he was a pastor of St. Luis Pastores Parish in Antigua, Guatemala. From 1997 through the first half of 2010 he served as a pastor at St. Teresa of the Child Jesus Parish in the Diocese of La Spezia, Italy. While in Italy he also provided spiritual direction at the diocesan seminary. From 2010 through September 2016 Father Luis served as the Prefect of Formation at the seminary of the Missionary Fraternity of Mary in Guatemala City. In September of 2016 he was elected Vicar General of the Society. He speaks Spanish, English, and Italian.

I hope that you will be satisfied with our presence and that a deep and lasting communion will be established between our Fraternity and your parish.
